Topic 2: Cooperation of International Innovation City of Asia and Europe	
<p>The European region includes economies and regions that have advanced technology and innovation such as the United Kingdom, Italy, and Central and Eastern Europe, which have outstanding advantages in technology research and development, science and technology finance, etc. Science and technology innovation cooperation between Asia and Europe has large potential and development value.
